Geography

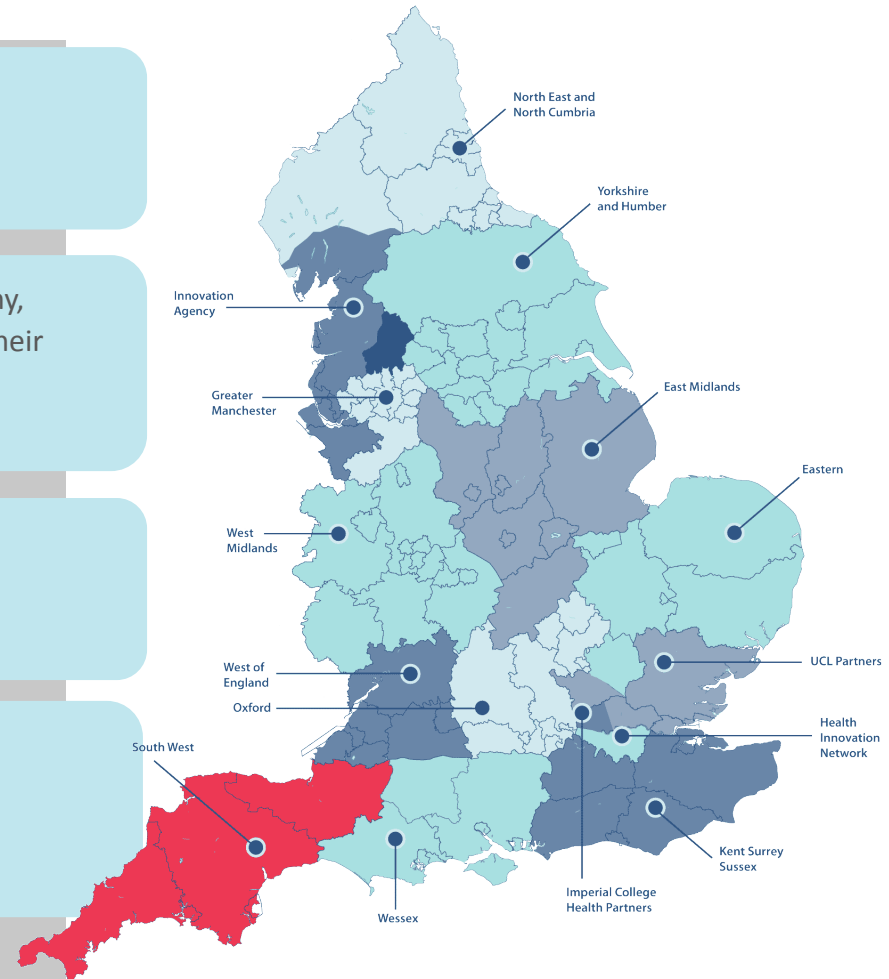
Each AHSN works across a distinct geography, supporting the needs of the population in their region. The SW AHSN is coterminous with Cornwall, Devon and Somerset STPs

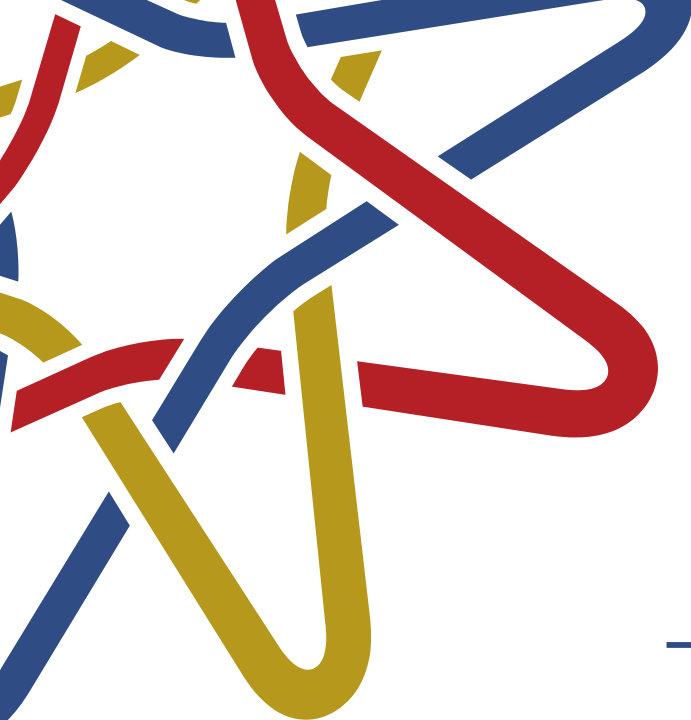
- Induction into social finance (*ART*)
